## The Planets and Love

### Mapping with the Love Planets: Your Galactic GPS

In this course, we are going to focus primarily on four heavenly bodies, which we'll refer to as "the love planets." Venus and Mars are Cupid's cosmic co-pilots, directing sensuality and sexuality—obviously important pieces of the romantic puzzle! But we are also going to track *amour* using the Sun and moon (which we realize aren't actual planets in science but are referred to that way in astrology). Since the Sun governs self-love and the moon your sense of security, understanding their influence can help you stay centered as you navigate the Sea of Love. While Venus and Mars primarily direct you in the relationship field, the Sun and moon have a strong influence on your individual needs, which must be tended to in order to keep partnerships in balance.

In truth, looking at your entire chart is helpful in **designing your dream relationship**. In this module, we'll review all of the planets, to help you create *your* unique love map. Even if you've studied your chart for years, viewing each planet through the lens of love is likely to bring refreshing new "navigation insights."

Are you new to astrology? Figuring out how this all fits together can be exciting *and* overwhelming, so take it in smaller bites, perhaps working with one or two of your planets per day this week. For the record, we've been studying astrology for over 20 years and we still have "aha!" moments. As we grow, expand and move through life's different stages, the planets in our chart reveal their influence to us in new ways.

Remember this: Astrology is an interpretive dance. We believe that there is no singular or "right" answer to what it means if, say, you have the moon in Gemini or Pluto in Scorpio. The point is to delve in and start exploring the ways you have been guided by each planet—and then, learning untapped possibilities for how to use their energy in the future.

With the astrological chart as your map, you can co-create with the universe. Just as you'd use that GPS to find your way to a particular city or national forest, once you arrive, you get to pick the first boutique district to shop or the most appealing trail to hike. Astrology can certainly inform your choices and help you make selections that cause your soul to sing!

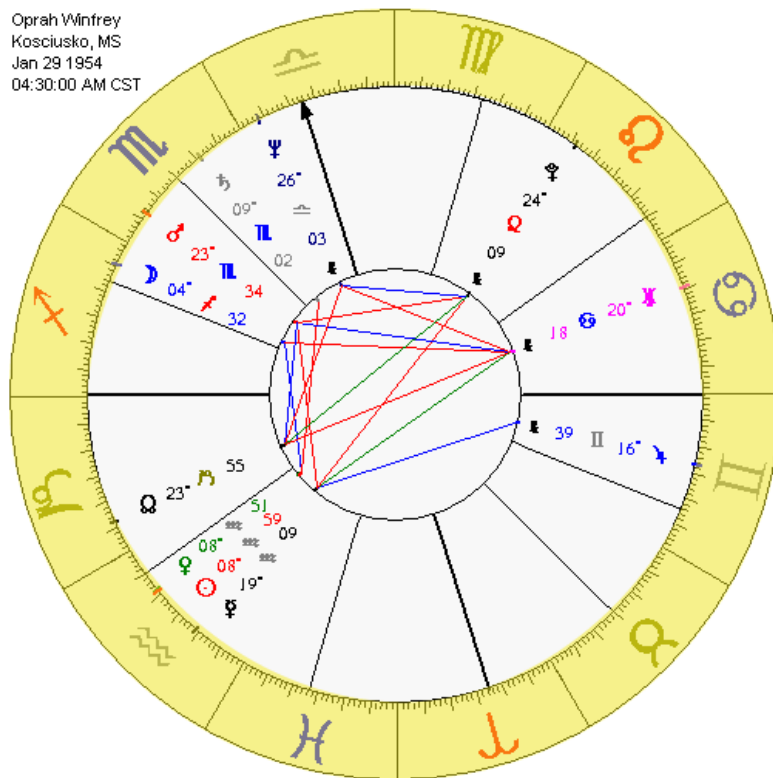

## The Zodiac Signs and Love

So, what exactly IS your astrological chart—or your "natal chart" or "birth chart" to use the official terminology? It's actually a freeze frame of the planets in their orbit viewed from our vantage point here on Earth.

We've all seen the science class diagrams of the planets making their circular orbit around the Sun. Astrology charts are just like that! The only difference is that the Earth is the center of the universe in this map and it's as if the Sun, moon and planets are orbiting around us.

The circle is then divided into 12 equal slices, like a clock, each measuring 30°. (Galactic Geometry 101:  $12 \times 30^\circ = 360^\circ$  or a full circle.) Each of those 12 slices represents the part of the sky ruled by one of the 12 zodiac signs.



### Has my zodiac sign changed as the constellations have shifted?

In a word, no. In ancient times the constellations *did* line up with the zodiac wheel, which is how each of the 12 wedges got its name. But as NASA reported (correctly), the constellations have shifted over time. In Western astrology—the system we use, which stems from the stargazing of the Babylonians and Greeks—the constellations were simply placeholders.

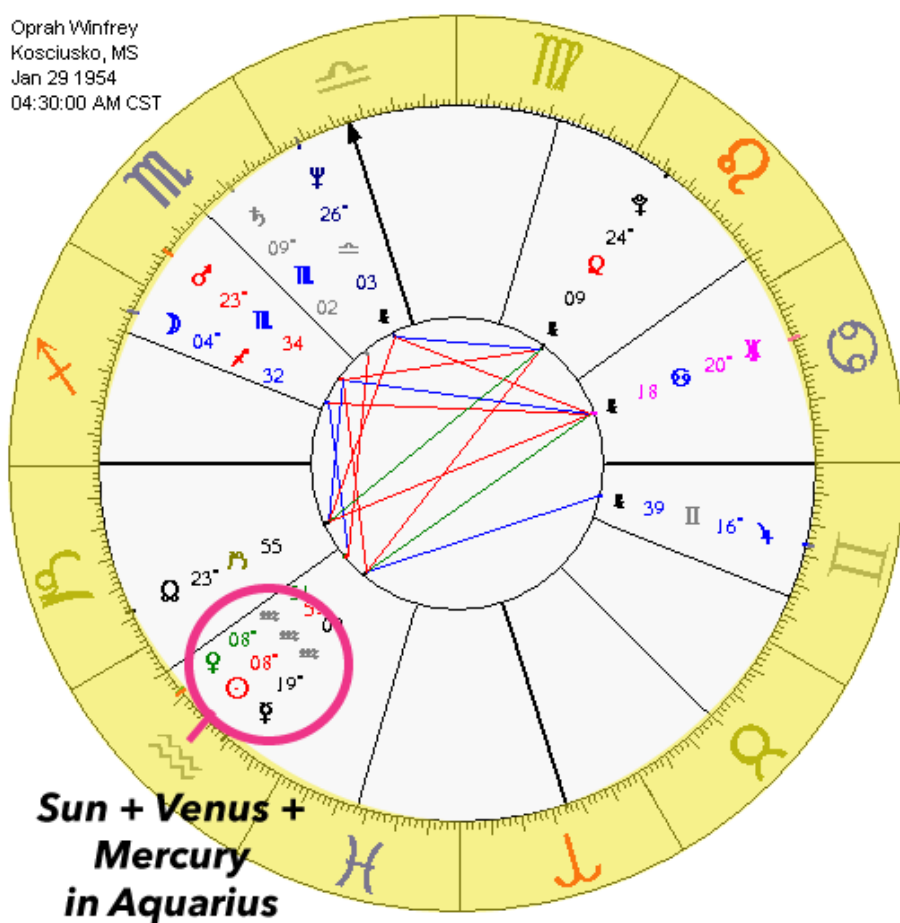
There are other (equally fascinating) "sidereal" systems, such as Vedic astrology, that track the planets in relation to the fixed stars that form constellations. In fact, a novice's "discovery" of this is how that 2016 rumor got started that your zodiac sign changed—and that there was a thirteenth sign called Ophiucus. As much as we'd love to add another celestial squad member to the mix (and one so closely named to Ophira, at

that) we are also happy to report that you are still the same sign as you've been reading since you began reading your 'scope.

### What does it mean that a planet is "in a sign?"

As we mentioned, your natal chart is like a screenshot of the sky at your exact moment of birth. While most people know their Sun sign—which is the one you've been reading about on Astrostyle—you may have been surprised to learn that you also have a moon sign, Venus sign, Neptune sign, and so on. Each one is like a specialized GPS, guiding you towards the love that *your* soul desires and needs.

As you take your first breath, each planet will be orbiting through one of the twelve slices of the zodiac wheel. When we "freeze frame" their motion in your chart, we can see exactly where they land.



Just as no two people are exactly the same—not even identical twins, trust us—the probability of all the planets lining up in the same formation twice is so rare that it's almost an impossibility! So unique is the birth chart, in fact, that only someone born at the same minute in the same time zone as you will share your chart.

As identical twins born four minutes apart, we have a few, albeit tiny, differences in our chart. Most notably: Tali, who was born first, has a rising sign of 9°37" Capricorn and Ophi's clocks in at 10°37". If you don't know your birth time, don't worry! Most planets move so slowly that it's easy to figure out what sign they are

stationed in. The Ascendant/rising sign, which changes signs every two hours may have to be "intuited"—and the moon sign, which shifts every 2.5 days may also be tricky to determine. (As you learn the zodiac, it may become obvious to you, however which sign it is.) The rest of the chart provides an incredibly rich landscape, giving you plenty to explore and obsess over!

## What the zodiac signs tell us about ourselves

The 12 zodiac signs progress from Aries to Pisces, paralleling the evolution of feelings from immediate to eternal. Each sign represents a different piece of the love journey. When a planet lands in this sign in your natal chart, it takes on the role of that particular zodiac sign—and will color your approach to *amour*.












## The Sun: Your Self-Love GPS

Great ball of fire! The Sun sign can be thought of as the essence self; the “me” that you show to the world. Solar energy radiates outward—think of sunbeams flooding the daytime sky. How do you represent yourself in the public; what impression do you leave on others? How can you be most radiant? This is what attracts certain people to you in the first place. It’s the special light you shine into the world. Since le Soleil is our energy source, your Sun sign can reveal places to draw your strength, confidence and courage—and keep on keeping on, even when you’ve had your heart shattered or love seems to be AWOL. The Sun also reveals what you want to be noticed for, the attention and validation you seek from a romantic partner. ## The Moon: Your Security GPS

My Moon is in (zodiac sign) \_\_\_\_\_

Security check! The moon shows what you need in order to feel “at home” in the world and in your relationships. Do you require a lot of verbal reassurance or do you feel loved when people encourage you to take risks and shine? Do you need your own space or do you want to move in together as fast as possible? Even the way you build a nest egg can be revealed by the moon’s position in your chart. The moon is often thought of as the counterpart to the Sun: el Sol is expressive while la luna is receptive. The Sun’s energy radiates outward while the moon processes all that heat and energy coming our way. What pushes your buttons? Where are you most sensitive? And how much emotion do you reveal?

Because the moon spins on its axis at the same speed that it orbits planet Earth, we can only glimpse half of her from our vantage point down here. There really is a dark side of the moon; it’s not just the trippy name of a Pink Floyd album. This metaphor totally translates to the moon’s role in the chart. Every moon sign has its own light side—the obvious feelings that we are comfortable with expressing. And, then, there’s a dark side: the emotions that creep up and catch us by surprise; ones we may even try to reject within ourselves. Understanding your moon sign can bring a deep sense of self-knowledge, but may also be a lifelong quest for understanding.
